Disposition of Pension Board Minutes for September 4th, 2019

Treasurers Report

Director Sarno -3^{rd} Quarter ending balance was \$1,484,309 which was an \$24,000 increase over the previous quarter.

New Business

1. Appoint Pension Board Member

Director Reed DISCUSSED. This was the end of the term for a Volunteer/Retired Member previously held by Member Dillman has come. Director Reed gave DIRECTION for A. Macdonald to send electronic self-nomination notifications for an election or a volunteer meeting night. Position to be filled at the March meeting. The eligible pool can be either a pensioner (whether they are vested or not) or a current volunteer. Chief Green stated we have four active volunteers. No action taken.

2. COLA Policy

As stated in the Pension Board Minutes from September 4th, 2019, Director Sarno requested a COLA (Administrative) Policy be presented for reasonable review for the Board to REVIEW and ADJUST the contributions to the Pension fund. It was last reviewed in 2016 or for any adjustment to cost of living to the Pension Fund. Director Sarno REQUESTED the increase be adopted with the policy since it would be a recommended adjustment contribution from \$50.00 to \$56.37 per year of service.

Director Pierson expressed support for the Policy and Adjustment

Director Reed expressed concern for approving the increase all at one time and had preference for an increase over time.

Chief Green provided clarification how future funds will be separated from Revenue and a specific amount of the Mill Levy can be dedicated amount for future certifications instead of Operating Funds like the District has historically.

Director Reed gave DIRECTION for Chief Green and A. Macdonald to develop a policy for filling or electing vacant positions on the Pension Board.

M/S Sarno/Pierson to ADOPT the draft COLA Policy and the ADJUSTMENT to \$56.37 per year of service. Voice vote unanimous; motion APPROVED.

Director Pettit REQESTED the ADJUSTMENT be stated clearly in the minutes as the adjustment is time sensitive to January 1st. FOR THE RECORD CLARIFICATION, THE AGENDA ITEM WAS REQUESTED AT THE SEPTEMBER PENSION MEETING BY DIRECTOR SARNO.
